Zoom Boom Ticket Tempe - Zoom Boom Training focuses on properly training potential operators on variable reach forklifts. The training goals include gaining the understanding of the equipments physics and to define the responsibilities of the operator. This program follows North American safety standards for lift trucks. Zoom boom training and certification is available at our site or at the company's location, provided there are a minimum number of people training. Certification given upon successfully finishing it is valid for three years.

The telehandler or also known as a telescopic handler is similar in numerous ways to a common forklift or a crane. This helpful machine is constructed with a telescopic boom that can lift upwards and extend forward. A variety of attachments can be fitted on the end of the boom, like for instance pallet forks, bucket, muck grab or lift table. It is popular in industry and agriculture settings.

Telehandlers are most commonly used with the fork attachment in order to shuttle loads. The units have the advantage that they can get to places inaccessible to regular forklifts. Telehandlers are capable of removing palletized loads from inside a trailer and placing them on places which are high like for instance rooftops. For some applications, they can be more practical and efficient as opposed to a crane.

The disadvantage of the telehandler is its instability when lifting heavier loads. When the boom extends with a load, the unit becomes increasingly unsteady. Counterweights situated at the back help, but don't solve the problem. When the working radius increases, the lifting capacity rapidly decreases. Some equipment come together with front outriggers which extend the lifting capacity while the equipment is stationary.
